

In March the LOVE INC Board of Directors announced that it was starting a fundraising campaign to raise money for the purchase and operation of the Klein Care Wagon that the organization and its partner Churches can use in mission to the community. One of the challenges faced by families in need in Central Virginia is for large items such as furniture and appliances. And we are blessed by many families willing to donate items for our brothers and sisters in need. However, it can be difficult to arrange for transportation of the items between the donors and the people in need.

Our goal is to raise \$15,000.00 initially, that we believe will qualify us for an additional grant, to get us to the cost of a used vehicle. By investing in a vehicle that can be used regularly in mission, we believe that the value of the benefit to the community will far exceed the costs of acquisition. On April 8, 2025, hundreds of religious community members from throughout Charlottesville and Albemarle met at the Martin Luther King Auditorium to pray together and to advocate for affordable housing and reliable transportation. One of the disheartening lessons that was communicated at the meeting was the fact that given the current lack of housing in our community, most often, if we are able to find housing for a previously unhomed family, it likely means that another person or family has been recently evicted. The faces change, but the number of our brothers and sisters without a home remains frustratingly constant.

LOVE INC receives calls and referrals on a daily basis from persons seeking assistance with rent and housing issues. Only united together as the body of Christ can we hope to address these needs.

Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter— when you see the naked, to clothe them, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear; then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard. Isaiah 58:6-7

Growing up in a small church in rural Alaska, one of my alltime favorite hymns, which we sang regularly was "They will know we are Christians," which says that our neighbors in the community will know we are Christians "by our Love." I think for a lot of us, those words are aspirational, but as a child, I took them as a given. I believed that what made us identifiable as Christians is our Love for our neighbors.

Too often today, I hear people disparaging our Churches and our congregations, for many sins. Some of their criticisms are fair; others are simply unkind.
